



A Day with Somebody's Hero Improv Theater Workshop and Anti-Bullying Performance

Artist fee: \$2000

Final cost to school: \$500

Includes:

- ★ Two hours of improv theater instruction with two instructors for one or two groups of up to thirty students, fourth grade or older.
- ★ Students participating in the workshops will get the chance to perform on stage with Somebody's Hero.
- ★ One 60 minute "Somebody's Hero" improvised performance with four players, focused on how to recognize and discourage bullying behavior.
- ★ Teacher's guide with correlation to relevant Oklahoma standards.

Available add-ons at additional cost:

- ★ Additional workshop sessions same day, \$100/hour
- ★ Two full days of workshops (includes all of the above), \$4200

Performing Arts Corps Grant Application Checklist:

- Talk with Monty Harper on the phone to arrange program details, including dates and times, (405) 624-3805.
- Visit the Oklahoma Arts Council's e-Grant Login Request Page to set up a school account. Your "Authorizing Official" (Principal) and your "Grant Coordinator" (you) will each get a login name and password.

- Mr. Harper will provide a contract. Mail a signed copy to the Oklahoma Arts Council. This is required support material for your PAC grant application.
Oklahoma Arts Council, P.O. Box 52001-2001, Oklahoma City, OK 73152-2001
- Log into the Oklahoma Arts Council's e-grant system and complete the Performing Arts Corps application. A notice of approval for funding will be emailed to you. Funding is provided on a first-come first-served basis.
- Once your application is accepted, your Authorizing Official must log into the e-grant system and approve the Oklahoma Arts Council contract electronically.
- Please be prepared to pay Somebody's Hero in full at the completion of their visit to your school.
- Complete a final report within 30 days after the program by logging into the e-grant system.
- After receiving your final report, the Oklahoma Arts Council will send a check for the amount of funding approved. The school can expect payment within two to four weeks.
- It's never too soon to start again for next year!
